

I have ordered recent Anatomy coloring books. And this one is great if you need basic info on the organs and their functions. But I was looking for a more descriptive and exact info. Dont be fooled by the 450 pg promise, there is one diagram per page so its only front sided and only offers at the most 7 spaces of labeling. I recommend this book for basic Anatomy.

I was happy to see that most all of the body system structures are contained within the pages of this golden book. The book included images of the skeletal, nervous, endocrine, digestive/urinary, respiratory and the cardiovascular system. I especially appriciated the muscle flashcards at the very end of the book. I'll even admit, it made my day. My only wish was that I would have ordered this book sooner. Overall, I am very pleased!

This is the best out of 3 anatomy coloring books I have had. I do rip out the pages any copy them before I color them so I can use them several times to quiz myself. So nice- like the easy to follow notes and explanations.

I really enjoyed this as an adjunct to my other books. I really needed to "see" what I was memorizing and I enjoyed copying and editing drawings. For me, redrawing, labeling and just recreating what I need to know nails it down in my brain. This book allowed me to do that. I took it to a printer and had them cut the binding and 3 hole punch to facilitate copying and redrawing. This really helped me and I carried straight A's throughout. A great addition to my library.Oh, and my grandson's like to make copies and color them as well. They can navigate the body as well as I can. It has become a bit of a family learning thing. Nothing like teaching to the next generation to help memorize things myself.

This book is not comprehensive enough for my high school teaching needs. If all you want is a *very* simplistic rendering of human anatomy, then this book will suffice. I would place this at a Jr. High/Middle school level. Kapit, et. al. is a far more complete and better for learning anatomy in my opinion.

I gave it 4 stars because it has a design flaw: for example, they ask you to label a. as "anterior clinoid process", and give you about enough space to write "wombat". Besides that, the book is great and sometimes does a better job explaining things than my lab TA, so bravo for that. Set me up with some good tunes, this book and some coloring pencils and I'm happy as a clam.

I am a non traditional student in my freshman year of school. My sister suggested I get one of these for extra help cause it helped her tremendously. Her class required it, my class didn't even mention it but my teacher uses these as a teaching aid. Very happy with this book!
